

READING IN RAZ KIDS

LEVEL UP!

LEVEL UP! is set for the beginning of the grade level your student is in or where they left off last year. If you choose to read in the LEVEL UP! your student will advance to the next level once they complete each book, and the books should have the check marks for completion. However, reading solely in LEVEL UP! is not mandatory.

WHAT IF LEVEL UP! IS TOO EASY?

Your student can go to the READING ROOM to read leveled books that are at their independent reading level. Parents/guardians will need to monitor to make sure the reading level is not too difficult in the READING ROOM. If unsure what level is appropriate, please contact the teacher.

WHAT IF THE LEVEL UP! IS JUST RIGHT?

Your student can read in LEVEL UP! to work toward moving up to the next level or they can read more books at their level in the READING ROOM in leveled up for more variety.

FLUENCY PRACTICE

Students can also record their reading using the record icon and listen to their recording after. Your student will receive credit for reading, listening to and quizzing on a book they read more than once. Books can be read again and again for fluency practice.

HOW TO COMPLETE A BOOK

LISTEN TO THE BOOK

KINDERGARTEN AND 1ST GRADE MUST LISTEN TO THE BOOK BEFORE READING.

2ND GRADE IS NOT REQUIRED TO LISTEN TO BOOKS, BUT LISTENING IS ENCOURAGED. PLEASE NOTE, YOU MUST LISTEN TO THE BOOK IF READING IN LEVEL UP! TO ADVANCE TO THE NEXT LEVEL.

READ THE BOOK

Students will choose a book to read in LEVEL UP! OR in the READING ROOM.

TAKE A QUIZ ON THE BOOK

If your student is unsure of a quiz answer, your student should click on the book icon on the top right corner of the quiz page. Then they can go back and reread to look for the answer in the text. If your student did not pass a quiz consider having your child reread the book before answering the missed questions again. Kindergarteners do not take a quiz at their first level aa.

HOW DO I ACCESS RAZ KIDS?

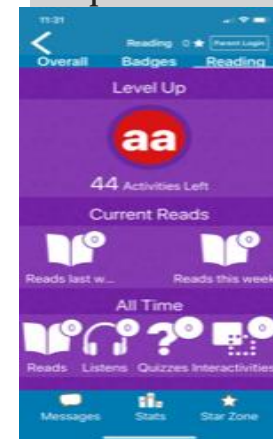
Step 1: Go to www.kidsa-z.com.

Step 2: Enter or choose the teacher's username.

Step 3: Your student chooses their first name and last name initial on the class chart.

Step 4: Your student enters their password (*The password is the student's last name in all lowercase letters, no spaces, or hyphens*).

Go for the gold! Students can earn a Reading Olympics gold medal when they complete 60 books!



RAZ Kids progress will be checked on December 8, March 9 and May 18. Gold medals will be awarded at the Thursday flag salute to those that earned a medal on December 15, March 16 and May 25.

May 18, 2023 is the last day to qualify for a gold medal.
